Current Bylaw that we are preparing an amendment proposal for:

Article VI, Section 6.6 Term of Office and Re-election.

"Officers are elected for one (1) term and shall be eligible for re-election to the same office but may not serve more than two (2) consecutive terms in the same office. An officer's term shall correspond to the current fiscal year (July 1st-June 30th). The outgoing president shall only serve in an advisory role in the next immediate term."

Proposed wording:

Article VI, Section 6.6 Term of Office and Re-election.

"Officers are elected for one (1) term and shall be eligible for re-election to the same office but may not serve more than two (2) consecutive terms in the same office, ***unless there are no other nominees for the given position, in which case an Officer may continue in the position as long as approved by a majority vote of the membership present and voting at the April meeting.*** An officer's term shall correspond to the current fiscal year (July 1st-June 30th). The outgoing president shall only serve in an advisory role in the next immediate term."
